**Dear Parents,**

The incidence of Dengue Hemorrhagic Fever is again on the rise. We would like to inform you that the school takes the necessary precautions to prevent **DENGUE** by carrying out the 4-S campaign of the Department of Health

1. Search and destroy mosquito breeding sites
  - o Daily cleaning of the classrooms, offices, and surroundings.
  - o Spraying of insecticides every Saturday in all the classrooms and offices.
  - o Daily cleaning of drains and stagnant pools of water.
  - o Regular surveillance of possible mosquito breeding grounds c/o the school's medical and housekeeping personnel.
  - o Use of a mosquito magnet, a device that attracts and traps mosquitos
2. Seek Early Treatment
  - o Students who are suspected to have fever are immediately sent to the school clinic. They are evaluated and sent home if they have fever. The parents are advised to seek consultation with their private doctor.
3. Say no to indiscriminate fogging
  - o Fogging is only done during a dengue outbreak
4. Self-protection measures
  - o In order to further implement self-protection measures the girls will be allowed to wear their PE uniform, which serves as their dengue uniform as well. Regular application of Mosquito Repellant Lotion every 6 hours is also advised.

Again, we appeal for your usual cooperation in promoting the well-being and ensuring the safety of our students.
